**Electrical Storms on a Golf Course:** Over the past few weeks there have been a number of thunderstorms with lightning present which is clearly evidenced by the tree at 17<sup>th</sup> West that was recently struck. This is a timely reminder of the dangers of lightning and Members are asked to use their common sense if a thunderstorm is threatening. The following are some of the safety precautions that should be taken in the event of a thunderstorm;

#### DO NOT;

- Be the tallest object in an area,
- Stand out in the open,
- Stand under a tree,
- Stand in a gazebo or open shelter,
- Stand next to metal objects,
- Stay next to water – ponds or running water – indoors or out.
- Handle objects that conduct electricity (eg. golf clubs, umbrellas),
- If in a group of people spread out, keeping several metres apart.
