Rules of Golf Corner

Members please remember that all hazard pegs are “**immovable obstructions**” as per the local rule on the back of the scorecard. The rule (24-2) relating to “immovable obstructions” states; **Immovable Obstruction. a. Interference;** Interference by an immovable obstruction occurs when a ball lies in or on the obstruction, or when the obstruction interferes with the player’s stance or the area of his intended swing. If the player’s ball lies on the putting green, interference also occurs if an immovable obstruction on the putting green intervenes on his line of putt. Otherwise, intervention on the line of play is not, of itself, interference under this Rule. **b. Relief** Except when the ball is in a water hazard or a lateral water hazard, a player may take relief from interference by an immovable obstruction as follows:

(i) Through the Green: If the ball lies through the green, the player must lift the ball and drop it without penalty within one club-length of and not nearer the hole than the nearest point of relief. The nearest point of relief must not be in a hazard or on a putting green. When the ball is dropped within one club-length of the nearest point of relief, the ball must first strike a part of the course at a spot that avoids interference by the immovable obstruction and is not in a hazard and not on a putting green.

Course Matters

#Areas of couch grass encroachment on the 11th, 16th and 17th River greens have been sprayed out and will be re-turfed prior to the greens renovation on November 12th. #Geotextile fabric will be installed on the right side green bunker on 12th West and one of the left side bunkers on 18th West to remove the stones and prevent further stone contamination. #A plastic grid structure is to be installed as a trial at the end of selected cart paths that is designed to stabilise and support turf in vehicular traffic areas. This will

hopefully assist maintain a grass cover in these areas. #Following on from last years successful course information gathering at the machinery shed, this years will be held on Monday December 3rd at 4.30pm DST.
